I hope this letter finds you, your extended family and all your loved ones well and safe as we continue to live with Covid in our community.

Teacher Assessed Grades Update

I am very pleased to confirm all the Teacher Assessed Grades for KS4 qualifications have been successfully submitted to the various examination boards.

Please be aware that we are still under instruction from JCQ and Ofqual that we are not to discuss the Teacher Assessed Grades with students or their families. The grades must remain confidential and will be subject to change until August 12. To break the confidentiality would constitute examination malpractice, resulting in sanctions being applied to the Academy.

We eagerly await Thursday 12 August, the day your child's results will be published and we can celebrate their well-deserved achievements.

Year 11 Results Arrangements

In order to get the exam results to your child as quickly as possible, they will be e-mailed to them via their lgfl school e-mail account at 8.30am on Thursday 12 August. This will allow them to have an electronic version of their results, which will support their enrolment at their chosen Post-16 provider.

I am mindful that some establishments are operating on a first come, first served system and we would therefore want our students to have their results as quickly as possible. Your child should **not** come to school to get their results on Thursday, but access them via their school e-mail account. The e-mail will come from 2036905@capita-intouch.co.uk and the subject of the e-mail will be 'Results 2021.'

If students have queries or have not received their results by 9.00am, they should contact the Academy via the results e-mail inbox: results@stpauls.greenwich.sch.uk

Students will receive an additional e-mail on August 12 informing them of the time and day they will be able to come in to the school to collect the paper copy of their results and pick up Yearbooks etc. These times will be either on Monday 16 August OR Tuesday 17 August.

Appeals Process

If students wish to appeal their grades, they must contact the school via the Appeals e-mail: appeals@stpauls.greenwich.sch.uk The e-mail must clearly indicate which subject grades are to be appealed and why.



There are two stages to Appeals this year; the Centre Review (St Paul's) and the Awarding Organisation appeal.

Stage 1: Centre Appeal can be made on the following grounds:

- If the Centre (St Paul's) failed to follow its procedures properly or consistently in arriving at that result

Or

- If the Centre (St Paul's) made an administrative error in relation to the result.

This e-mail must be sent to appeals@stpauls.greenwich.sch.uk before Friday 3 September 2021. Any appeals after this stage will not be accepted.

Stage 2: Awarding Organisation appeal can be made on the following grounds,
AFTER YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE OUTCOME OF THE CENTRE REVIEW (Stage 1)

- If it is considered that there has been a procedural error or an administrative error

Or

- That the grade reflects an unreasonable exercise of academic judgement (either because of the way that the grade has been determined and/or the selection of the evidence.)

This e-mail must be sent to the school before Friday 17 September 2021. Any appeals after this stage will not be accepted by the Awarding Organisations.

I would like to end this letter with my thanks to each and every one of you for the great support you have given St Paul's during your child's time at the Academy.


