Dear Parents, Carers and Families,

As you will know, over the last 2 weeks, we have been following Government Guidelines to remain open to as many students as possible. At 5pm this evening, however, we received the attached letter from Councillor Danny Thorpe from the Royal Borough of Greenwich that directs us to close the premises to the majority of our students with the exception of any key worker children or students with specific needs. This means that as from Tuesday, students are to stay at home and move to Remote Learning.

During 15th-17th December your child will be provided with the lessons and learning activities for the lessons they would usually have at school. Lessons will be shared via **Google Classroom**, so your child will need some form of technology to enable them to gain access to their lessons. Google Classroom can be accessed on phones, tablets, laptops and PCs.

From Tuesday 15th until Thursday 17th December, the Academy will only be open for:
