T Levels - Apprenticeship-only subjects

T levels will not be available in some subjects, which instead will follow an apprenticeship-only route. These are as follows:

Community exercise, fitness and health (Health and Science route)

Hospitality (Catering and Hospitality route)

Protective services (Protective Services route)

Customer services (Sales, Marketing and Procurement route)

Marketing (Sales, Marketing and Procurement route)

Procurement (Sales, Marketing and Procurement route)

Retail (Sales, Marketing and Procurement route)

Care Services (Care Services route)

Transport (Transport and Logistics route)

Logistics (Transport and Logistics route)

The International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB) consists of 6 subjects (3 higher and 3 standard), for the six subjects you have to choose one from each of these six lists:

- Maths list
- English list
- Science list
- Humanities/Social Science list
- Languages list
- Arts/Practical list.

Usually you have the option to choose to ignore the Arts/Practical list and take a subject instead from the Science or Languages list etc. if you want to.

Plus you have to study 3 core elements including:

- Creativity Activity Service (CAS) (take part in events and activities in the local community)
- A 4000 word essay
- The Theory of Knowledge (a new subject to all students)
